DRIVE TO APULSTOCK

Car parking is available on site. Minibuses and coaches are advised to book spaces via the office at Ferring Country Centre. Call (01903) 245078.



TRAVEL TO APULSTOCK BY BUS



The closest bus stop to Ferring Country Centre is on the 700 Route. Hop off at Ferring Library - then it's a 5-minute walk.



RIDE THE TRAIN TO APULSTOCK

The nearest train station is Goring, which is a 20-minute walk (1.3 miles) to Ferring Country Centre.



Picnics, rugs, and camp chairs are welcome, however, due to licensing laws, only alcohol purchased at the FCC bar may be consumed at Apulstock.

Ferring Country Centre is normally a smoking/vaping free site, however an area will be made available for Apulstock guests. Please be cool and respect our amazing hosts.

CAMPING AT APULSTOCK
